ELECTORAL REGISTRATION

There are two versions of the Register. The **full version** which lists everyone who is entitled to vote is only available to certain people and organisations for specified purposes. The **edited version** is available to anyone who requests it to use for any purpose. You can choose whether or not you wish your name to appear on the edited Register.

Giving notice under Section 11 of the Data Protection Act 1998

Because of the public nature of the Edited Register, there is the option for any person who registers to vote to decide whether or not they want their details to be included in this version. In order to ensure an elector's details are NOT included in the edited version, they are asked to 'opt-out' of it. This option is given on every registration form and annual registration form sent out by the Electoral Registration Officer.

There is however the option to ask for your details to be PERMANENTLY removed from the Edited Register of Electors under Section 11 of the Data Protection Act 1998.

Under Section 11 of the Data Protection Act 1998, a person can give notice that they do not want their personal information to be used for direct marketing. If you give notice under Section 11, the Electoral Registration Officer must ensure that your data is permanently removed from the Edited Register of Electors so that it is not available for purchase. If you give notice, the Electoral Registration Officer will record that you have made the permanent choice that you do not want to appear on the Edited Register now or in the future.
