Publication of revised final recommendations for the Community Governance review of Crowton parish

Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

As part of the current Community Governance Review of Crowton parish, under the terms of reference published on 2 August 2012, the Community Governance Review Committee of Cheshire West and Chester Council has made the following revised final recommendations to be subject to a further final period of consultation prior to being agreed by Council:

That:

- 1) the boundary of the existing parish of Crowton be redrawn to the north at Pickerings Lock to transfer the properties of Primrose Cottage, Pickerings Bridge Cottage and The Bungalow from Dutton parish to Crowton parish;
- 2) the boundary of the existing parish of Crowton be redrawn to the north-east at Acton Mill to transfer the property of The Grange from Acton Bridge parish to Crowton parish;
- 3) the boundary of the existing parish of Crowton be redrawn to the south at Bag Lane to transfer the properties of 1 Jubilee Cottages and 2 Jubilee Cottages from Cuddington parish to Crowton parish;
- 4) the boundary of the existing parish of Crowton be redrawn to the south and east of Town Farm Quarry to transfer The Poplars, Two Dee's and Darley Cottage from Norley parish to Crowton parish;
- (i) the boundary of the existing parish of Crowton be redrawn to the south of Sandhole Lane to transfer Beechwood Farm, Kennel Lodge, Beechwood Cottage, Norley Bank Lodge, Bratts Bank Cottage, Peover House, Five Oaks Farm, Burgess Cottage, The Croft, Bratts Bank Farm, Camomile Farm, Virginia Lodge, Park View House, Clemley Cottage, Mostyn House and Marbry Cottage from Crowton parish to Norley parish;
- (ii) the parish of Crowton should not be abolished;
- (iii) the name of the parish of Crowton should not be altered;
- (iv) the parish should continue to have a parish council;
- (v) no changes be made to the electoral arrangements that apply to the parish council; and
- (vi) a Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1 April 2015.

N.B. The above revised final recommendations replace those previously published on 20 December 2013.



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Reasons for the recommendation

To enable completion of the community governance review of Crowton parish in accordance with statutory guidance and in line with local preference; to determine more appropriate parish boundaries which reflect the identities and interests of local residents; and to endorse that current community governance arrangements are effective.
