

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(A483 WREXHAM ROAD, CHESTER)
(TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

Whereas the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the traffic authority for the lengths of road listed in the Schedule to this Order, (hereinafter called “the Highways”) is satisfied that traffic on the Highways should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.


Now therefore the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as the “Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (A483 Wrexham Road, Chester) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2025 It shall come into operation on 14th March 2025 and shall continue in force for a period of eighteen months or until the said safety concerns are resolved whichever is the sooner.

**Schedule
(30 MPH Speed Limit)**

A483 Wrexham Road, Chester, from a point 400 metres south of Overleigh Roundabout to the northerly junction of Herons Way.
