(Act of Remembrance)

(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Notice 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic as identified in Chester because of the likelihood of danger to the public for the Act of Remembrance in Chester City Centre on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2026, for 1 day only.

**The following lengths of road will be closed from 10:30 to 11:30 on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2026.**

- Northgate Street (Princess Street to Eastgate Street)
- St Werburgh Street (Northgate Street to Eastgate Street)
- Eastgate Street (Northgate Street to Foregate Street)
- Foregate Street (Eastgate Street to Love Street)
- St John Street (Foregate Street to Little St John Street)

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Notice shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.
