

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
12 Days of Christmas
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Notice 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in the Chester City Ward to enable the Chester Christmas Parade to be carried out by the organiser.

The Order will come into force on Thursday 19th November 2026 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed:

The following lengths of road will be closed for the duration between 18:00 to 20:30

Northgate Street (From Hunter Street to Princess Street)
Princess Street (From Northgate Street to a point 8m west of Northgate Street)

The following lengths of road will be closed from 20:00 to 20:30

Northgate Street (From Princess Street to Eastgate Street)
St Werburgh Street (From Northgate Street to Eastgate Street)
Eastgate Street (From Northgate Street to Foregate Street)
Foregate Street (From Eastgate Street to St John Street)
St John Street (From Foregate Street to Little St John Street)
Watergate Street (From Bridge Street to Nicholas Street)

The following lengths of road will be closed from 17:30 to 20:30

Hamilton Place (from Crook Street to Goss Street)
The following lengths of roads will be closed from 18:40 to 18:55hrs
Hamilton Place from Crook Street to Trinity Street
Trinity Street from Hamilton Place to a point 60m south of Hamilton Place
Weaver Street from Commonhall Street to a point 50m north of Commonhall Street
Commonhall Street full length
Pierpoint Court full length

The following lengths of roads will be closed from 18:50 to 19:15hrs

Bridge Street (From Pepper Street to a point 6 metres north of Feathers Lane)
Whitefriars from Bridge Street to Pierpoint Court

The Order will also:

Suspend parking, loading and unloading from 16:00 to 20:30 on:

Hamilton Place (from Crook Street to Goss Street)

And suspend parking loading and unloading from 16:30 to 20:30 on:

Northgate Street (From Hunter Street to Princess Street)
Princess Street (From Northgate Street to a point 8m west of Northgate Street)

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times. Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.
