RECOMMENDED ACTION IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

If at any time you become aware of a large gas escape or major problem at the site:

Telephone the Emergency Services on 999 (or 112) and National Gas Emergency Service on 0800 111 999.

If you are requested to evacuate:

- Switch off electronic equipment, extinguish naked flames and remove other sources of ignition.
- Evacuate the building and secure the premises.
- ➤ Identify and record that all members of your household and/or staff are accounted for and present and report these numbers to the Emergency Services.
- Advise others in the affected area to accompany you.
- Do not allow any person to re-enter the building until authorised to do so by a Police Officer.

If at any time you are requested to leave your premises by the Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Cadent, follow the above procedure unless instructed otherwise.

ACTIONS TO FOLLOW IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY AT THE SITE



Warning of Danger

If you become aware of a large gas escape or a large fire at the site, telephone:



Emergency Services – 999 (or 112)

and

National Gas Emergency Service – 0800 111 999



Go to a Safe Place

Go indoors and stay there, warn passers-by, tell your family and, if possible, quickly warn any elderly or otherwise vulnerable neighbours.

Close windows and stay well away from windows nearest to the site. The Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Cadent will advise you if you need to take further action.



Keep Safe

Do not go outside.

Leave children at school, the school will look after them.

Do not go to look for pets, your safety is more important.
