

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
(Chester Pride)
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in the Chester City Ward to enable the Chester Pride event to be carried out by the organiser.

The Order will close the following roads between 11:30 and 13:30 on Saturday 15th August 2026.

- Castle Street (from Lower Bridge Street to Grosvenor Roundabout).
- Lower Bridge Street (from Duke Street to Pepper Street).
- Bridge Street (from Pepper Street to Watergate Street).
- Pepper Street (from Bridge Street to St John Street).
- Watergate Street (from Bridge Street to Nicholas Street).
- Northgate Street (from Princess Street to Eastgate Street).
- St Werburgh Street (from Northgate Street to Eastgate Street).
- Eastgate Street (from Foregate Street to Northgate Street).
- Foregate Street (from Eastgate Street to St John Street).
- St John Street (from Foregate Street to Little St John Street).
- Vicars Lane (from Little St John Street to Love Street).
- Love Street - Southbound Only (from Foregate Street to Vicars Lane).

The Order will close the following road between 09:00 and 20:00 on Saturday 15th August 2026.

- Castle Street (from Grosvenor Roundabout to St Mary's Hill).

The order will introduce two-way travel on the following roads between 11:30 and 13:30 on Saturday 15th August 2026.

- Park Street (from Albion Place to Albion Street).

The order will introduce two-way travel on the following roads between 10:30 and 20:00 on Saturday 15th August 2026.

- Castle Street (from Lower Bridge Street to St Mary's Hill).

The order will also suspend parking, loading, and unloading on the following lengths of road between 08:00 and 13:30 on Saturday 15th August 2026.

- St Werburgh Street (full length).
- Bridge Street (from White Friars to a point 13m north of Feathers Lane).
- Eastgate Street (from St Werburgh Street to Foregate Street).
- Foregate Street (from Eastgate Street to St John Street).
- St Johns Street (full length).

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
