

#### We want:

• There to be enough places for older people to live in their local area.



• People to be as independent as possible.



• People to be involved in their local area where they live.



We want the places for people to live to be:

• Affordable.



• Easy to change to meet people's needs.



• Close to home.





We want to work with services and local communities to help people to get the support that is right for them.



We want the right services to be available that can:

• Support people in the ways they want.



• Involve people and their families in planning what support they need.



#### **Dementia**

**Dementia** is a disease in the brain. It affects your memory and behaviour.



We want people with dementia to be given the right housing and support.

# Different types of accommodation



There are many different types of accommodation for older people.



#### These include:

- Own homes. These could be:
  - Owned by the person.



 Rented from a landlord or housing association.



 Independent accommodation. This is a place where you can be as independent as you want, but with support when you need it. It could be:



 Respite care - where you go somewhere to stay for a short break.



 Extra Care Housing - where you have your own home in a place where there is also support available.



 Sheltered Housing - where you have your own home, but there is someone in the building who can help you if you need it.



• Care Homes. This is where you go to live and get care and support any time of the day or night.

Care Homes are for people who need a lot of care and support.


