

Parking with a Non-Uk Parking Permit

Visitors to Cheshire West & Chester from outside the UK are reminded that use of their Parking Card is entirely at the discretion of the police and local authority of the area they are visiting.

The UK Government's advice for visitors outside EU / EEA is to bring your Parking Card with you and check locally with the police or local authority to see if it can be used. **Do not park without this official approval.** The UK Parking Card is used in conjunction with a parking disc, a visitor from another country who displays their Parking Card without a parking disc will not be given the same concessions if they don't display an approved permit.

Visitors to Cheshire West & Chester from another EU/EEA member can apply for a permit from Cheshire West and Chester Blue Badge department by calling 0300 123 7040. Upon obtaining approval they should then print, complete and display the notice on page two of this document next to their Parking Card on the vehicle dashboard.
