Emergency Instruction Leaflet

Residents & Businesses that fall within the Public Information Zone
for the Stublach Gas Storage Facility

About Storengy

Storengy UK, operates the largest onshore underground natural gas storage facility in the UK based here in Cheshire on the Stublach site. We've been operating since 2014, on the 420-hectare site. Safety is of the upmost importance to our operations, therefore we would like to share with you some safety steps to follow in the extremely rare occasion of an incident on our site.



Storengy UK Stublach Gas Storage Facility

Natural gas is extremely flammable and under the Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) Regulations 2015, natural gas is classified as a hazardous substance due to the potential to cause fire and/or explosion.

The COMAH Regulations require Storengy UK to prepare and submit a safety report to the COMAH Competent Authority (consisting of the Health & Safety Executive alongside the Environmental Agency) describing the processes, procedures and measures in place to prevent major accidents on the Stublach site. The COMAH Competent Authority carries out regular, pre-planned intervention visits to verify that the control measures detailed within the safety report, designed to ensure the health and safety of those working on the site and in the local community, are maintained.

The COMAH Regulations also require Storengy UK to provide information that details the actions to be taken in the unlikely event of an emergency on the Stublach site to neighbours and businesses that fall within a pre-defined Public Information Zone.

Please read the instructions contained within this leaflet and share with all members of your household. Please keep this leaflet in an accessible location and pass on to any subsequent occupier of your property. This leaflet should be displayed prominently in any business or community premises.

Actions to follow in the event of an emergency:

1



Visit Storengy UK website www.storengy.co.uk for the most up to date details

2



Tune into local radio information and advice will be broadcast on a number of frequencies

3



Do Not leave the area, you may travel into danger or hinder access required by the emergency services

4



Advise and assist any elderly, deaf, blind or disabled neighbours

5



If you are outside go into a house or building

6



Close doors and windows and switch off ventilation and air conditioning

7



Co-operate fully with instructions given by the emergency services

8



Remain indoors until the emergency is over. The emergency services will give the 'All Clear'

9

For updates on a site emergency please call **0800 917 9799** where a recorded message will provide up to date information
