

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
Christleton 5k
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following roads in the Christleton & Huntington Ward to enable Christleton 5k event to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Friday 8th May 2026 and will close the following lengths of roads from 19:15 until 20:45 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed:

- Rake Lane (entire length).
- Birch Heath Lane (entire length).
- Village Road (entire length).
- Plough Lane, from its junction with Village Road to its junction with Rake Lane.

The Order will also suspend no waiting, no loading/unloading, and no blue badge parking on the following lengths of road from 18:00 until 20:30 on Friday 8th May 2026.

- Village Road (entire length).
- Plough Lane, from its junction with Village Road to its junction with Rake Lane.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.

The promoter of the event is Cheshire Triathlon Club.
