

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
Ellesmere Port Running Club 5k
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in the Parishes of Capenhurst and Ledsham to enable the Ellesmere Port Running Club 5k to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Wednesday 12th August 2026 and will close the following lengths of roads from 19:00 until 20:00 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed:

- Rectory Lane, from its junction with Capenhurst Lane to its junction with Chapel Lane.
- Ledsham Lane, from its junction with Rectory Lane to its junction with Ledsham Village.
- Ledsham Village, from its junction with Ledsham Lane to its junction with Chapel lane.
- Chapel Lane, from its junction with Capenhurst Lane to its junction with A540 Parkgate Road.
- Capenhurst Lane, from its junction with A540 Parkgate Road to its junction with Dunkirk Lane.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.

The promoter of the event is Ellesmere Port Running Club.
