

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
Farndon Soapbox
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Notice 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in the Parish of Farndon to enable the Farndon Soapbox to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Sunday 13th September 2026 and will close the following lengths of roads from 06:00 until 20:00 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed.

- Churton Road, from its junction with Townfield Lane to its junction with High Street.
- High Street, from its junction with Bridge Street to its junction with Church Street).
- River Lane, to a point 60 metres west from High Street.
- Bridge Street, from its junction with High Street to its junction with Green Street. Part of Wrexham Council road.

The Order will also suspend no waiting, no loading/unloading and no blue badge parking on the following lengths of roads from 00:01 until 20:00 on Sunday 13th September 2026.

- Churton Road, from its junction with Townfield Lane to its junction with High Street.
- High Street, from its junction with Bridge Street to its junction with Church Street).
- River Lane, to a point 60 metres west from High Street.
- Bridge Street, from its junction with High Street to its junction with Green Street. Part of Wrexham Council road.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR TRAFFIC

Traffic diverted from High Street via Barton Road, B5130, A534 Wrexham Road and the B5102 Wrexham Road to Holt. The reverse route applies.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the above roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.

The promoter of the event is the Farndon Soapbox committee along with the Hospice of the Good Shepherd.
