

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
University of Chester Graduation Ceremonies
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic as identified in Chester because of the likelihood of danger to the public for the University of Chester Graduation Ceremonies in Chester city centre from the 25th to the 26th March 2026.

The Order will come into force on Wednesday 25th until Thursday 26th March 2026 and will close the following lengths of roads between 10:30 until 17:00 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed

- Northgate Street, from its junction with Hunter Street to its junction with Eastgate Street.
- Princess Street (entire length).
- St Werburgh Street (entire length).
- Eastgate Street, from its junction with Northgate Street to its junction with Foregate Street.
- Foregate Street, from its junction with Eastgate Street to its junction with St John Street.
- St John Street, from its junction with Foregate Street to its junction with Little St John Street.

The Order will also suspend no waiting, no loading/unloading, no blue badge parking on the following lengths of roads on Wednesday 25th until Thursday 26th March 2026 between 07:30 until 17:00 as detailed below.

- Northgate Street, from its junction with Hunter Street to its junction with St Werburgh Street.
- Princess Street (entire length).
- St Werburgh Street (entire length).
- Eastgate Street, from its junction with St Werburgh Street to its junction with Foregate Street.
- Foregate Street, from its junction with Eastgate Street to its junction with St John Street.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and agreed vehicles linked to the safety and logistics for the event delivery.

The promoter of these events is the University of Chester.
