Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984  
VE Day 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary  
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic as identified in Chester because of the likelihood of danger to the public for the VE Day 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in Chester City Centre on 08<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

***The notice will close the following lengths of road from 20:00 – 22:00 on Thursday 08<sup>th</sup> May 2025.***

Northgate Street (From Hunter Street to Eastgate Street)  
St Werburgh Street (From Northgate Street to Eastgate Street)  
Eastgate Street (From Northgate Street to Foregate Street)  
Foregate Street (From Eastgate Street to St Johns Street)  
St John Street (From Foregate Street to a point approximately 35m south of Foregate Street)

The order will also suspend parking, loading and unloading from 16:00 to 22:00  
Northgate Street (from Hunter Street to St Werburgh Street)  
St Werburgh Street (Full Length)  
Eastgate Street (St Werburgh Street to Foregate Street)  
Foregate Street (From Eastgate Street to St John Street)

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

The promoter of the event is Cheshire West and Chester Council.
