

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
(Reorganisation of Community Governance)
(Clotton Hoofield) Order 2019

Made *2019*
Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (“the Council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 21st February 2019.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Clotton Hoofield) Order 2019.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3) below, this Order shall come into force on 1st April 2019.
- (3) For the purposes of:
 - (a) this article, and
 - (b) proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of

parish councillors for the parish of Clotton Hoofield, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019, this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“borough” means the borough of Cheshire West and Chester;

“map” means the map marked “Clotton Hoofield Parish Map 2015” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act; and

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Area affected by the order

4. The area affected by this Order is shown on the map.

Number of parish councillors

5. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Clotton Hoofield shall be eight.

Electoral register

6. The registration officer for the borough shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Order date

7. 1st April 2019 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council has undertaken community governance reviews of parishes within the borough of Cheshire West and Chester and has made recommendations for the reorganisation of community governance to come into effect from 1st April 2019.

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Clotton Hoofield and Iddinshall) Order 2015 established a new parish of Clotton Hoofield and the creation of a new parish council within the Borough from 1st April 2015.

This Order gives effect to recommendations made in 2019 by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Clotton Hoofield to increase the number of parish councillors from seven to eight.

The number of parish councillors will be increased with effect from 1st April 2019

Article 6 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map defined in article 2 shows the existing parish of Clotton Hoofield. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council.
