

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
(Tilston 10k)
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in the Farndon and Malpas Wards to enable the Tilston 10k to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Sunday 30th June 2024 and will close the following roads from 09:00 for a maximum duration of 2 hours and 45 minutes.

Roads to be closed as detailed below:

- Church Road (from Long Lane to Parr Green Lane).
- Parr Green Lane (from Church Road to Worthenbury Road).
- Soughans Lane (from Parr Green Lane to Chorlton Lane).
- Chorlton Lane – North (from Mill Lane to Whitewood Lane).
- Chorlton Lane – Northwest (from Whitewood Lane to Parr Green Lane).

Alternative routes for traffic as detailed below:

- Stretton Hall Lane / A534 / Worthenbury Road.
- Flennens Brook Road / Frog Lane.
- B5069 Wrexham Road.
- Tilston Road.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

The promoter of the event is Tilston Playing Field Association.
