### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER**

#### **Highways Act 1980 section 119**

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Public Footpath No 7 (Part) Moulton) Public Path Diversion Order 2018 No 2**

The above Order, made on the 24 July 2018, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that length of Public Footpath 7 in the parish of Moulton commencing at OS grid reference SJ 66110 69362 then running in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 112 metres to OS grid reference SJ 66007 69398 to a new line commencing at Jack Lane (UY 2777) at OS grid reference SJ 66109 69363 then running in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 14 metres to OS grid reference SJ 6609 6936 then running in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 5 metres to the footway of the adoptable road and continuing to run over that footway in a generally west north westerly direction for 54 metres then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 5 metres to OS grid reference SJ 66036 69388 then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 2 metres and then running in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 27 metres to OS grid reference SJ 66010 69398 then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 3.2 metres to join the existing public footpath 7 at OS grid reference SJ 66007 69398

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
