NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 section 119

The Cheshire West and Chester (Public Footpaths Nos 12 (part) and 23 (part) Barrow) Public Path Diversion Order 2016

The above Order, made on the 1st March 2016, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert Public Footpath No. 12 in the parish of Barrow commencing at O.S. grid reference SJ 4764 6973 then running in a generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 274 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 47896963 to a new line commencing on Broomhill Lane at O.S. grid reference SJ 4770 6983 then running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 237 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 4789 6969 then running in a generally south westerly direction along the west side of a fence line for approximately 31 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 4787 6966 then running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to OS grid reference SJ 4789 6963 AND Public Footpath No. 23 in the parish of Barrow commencing at O.S. grid reference SJ 47797 69684 then running in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 3.5 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 47799 69689 to a new line commencing at the termination point of Footpath No 11 at O.S. grid reference SJ 47746 69700 then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 5 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 47748 69705 then running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 55 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 47799 69689

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
