The effect of the order will be to divert that length of Public Footpath No 1 Bridge Trafford commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 4492 7114 then running in a north easterly direction for approximately 60 metres to OS grid reference SJ 4489 7119 on to a line commencing on the Warrington Road (A56) at OS grid reference SJ 4492 7112 then running in a westerly direction for approximately 49 metres to OS grid Reference SJ 4488 7114 then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 50 metres to OS grid reference SJ 4492 7114 then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 50 metres to OS grid reference SJ 4492 7114
