

# Officer Decision Notice

The following decision has been taken under the Council's Constitution as amended.

**Decision Maker:** Highways Commissioner

**Decision in matter of:** section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990  
diverting a section of Footpath 11 Rushton

**Decision:**

1. It is confirmed that an application report in respect of the above-mentioned matter ("the Report") has been prepared and Notice given to the Ward Member on 16 July 2021 in accordance with paragraph 14 of section B5 –committee Procedure Rules of the Council's Constitution ("the Call-In Procedure").
2. It is confirmed that the Report has not been called-in for decision by the Planning Committee in accordance with paragraph 14.2 of the Call-In Procedure.
3. Accordingly, the Highways Commissioner pursuant to the powers set out above and to paragraph 14.9 of the Call-In procedure does hereby confirm the recommendation contained in the Report (reproduced below) as a decision of the Council.

**The Recommendation:-**

- 1) That an Order be made under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the 1990 Act") diverting a part of Footpath No 11 ("FP 11") in the Parish of Rushton and shown on Plan SD075 ("the Plan") on the grounds that it is necessary to do so to enable development to be carried out in accordance with Planning Permission granted under reference 21/00475/FUL ("the Permission").
- 2) That, if no objections are received, the Highway Commissioner be authorised to take any action considered necessary in respect of the confirmation of the Order duly authorised to be made.
