

NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
THE CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATHS NO.6 (PART), NO. 7 (PART), NO. 9 (PART) AND NO. 45 (PART)
ELLESMERE PORT) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017

The above Order was made on the 8 June 2017. The effect of the order will be to divert the length of Public Footpath No 6 in Ellesmere Port commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 3656 7574 then running in a north north easterly direction for approximately 259 metres to OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 on to a line commencing from the unaffected part of the footpath at OS grid reference SJ 3656 7574 then running along a boulevard set back from the adopted highway in a generally westerly direction for approximately 45 metres at OS grid reference SJ 3652 7575 to the proposed adopted highway and then commencing again at the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3605 7575 and running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 163 metres to the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3652 7591 and commencing again at the proposed adopted highway at OSGR SJ 3652 7594 and running in a generally northerly then easterly direction for approximately 119 metres to the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 and commencing again at the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 then running in a generally easterly direction for approximately 56 metres to the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3666 7600 AND Public Footpath No 7 in Ellesmere Port commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 3646 7619 then running in a southerly direction for approximately 230 metres to OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 to a new line commencing at OS grid reference SJ 3646 7619 then running through public open space in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 208 metres to join the proposed pedestrian boulevard at OS grid reference SJ 3654 7600 AND Public Footpath No 9 in Ellesmere Port commencing on Gerrard Avenue (UV3298) at OS grid Reference SJ 3703 7579 then running in a north westerly direction for approximately 483 metres to the junction with Footpaths 7, 45 and 6 at OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 to a new line commencing on Gerrard Avenue (UV3298) at OS grid reference SJ 3703 7579 then running through public open space in a generally westerly then north westerly direction for approximately 303 metres to a proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 6381 7589 continuing from the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3679 7591 and running in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 83 metres to the diverted part of Footpath 45 at OS grid reference SJ 3676 7599 AND Public Footpath No 45 in Ellesmere Port commencing on Pennistone Drive (UV1340) at OS grid Reference SJ 3676 7614 then running in a south westerly direction for approximately 216 metres to OS grid reference SJ 3660 7600 to a new line commencing on Pennistone Drive at OS grid reference SJ 3703 7579 then running through public open space in a generally southerly then westerly direction for approximately 264 metres to join the proposed adopted highway at OS grid reference SJ 3667 7599

Please state the grounds on which they are made. If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cheshire West and Chester Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
