

## **NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER**

### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257**

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Footpath No 9 (part), No 10 (part) and No 11 (part), Davenham) Public Path Diversion Order 2017**

The above Order was made on the 24 January 2017. The effect of the order will be to divert the length of

That length of Public Footpath No 9 in the Parish of Davenham commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 65873 70465 then running in a north easterly direction for approximately 6 metres to OS grid reference SJ 65876 70473 to a new line commencing at OS grid reference SJ 65873 70465 then running in a generally westerly then northerly direction for approximately 12 metres to rejoin the southern end of Fountain Lane at OS grid Reference SJ 65876 70473

That length of Public Footpath No 10 in the Parish of Davenham commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 65876 70473 then running in a north westerly direction for approximately 246 metres to OS grid reference SJ 65734 70638 to a new line commencing at OS grid reference SJ 65986 70349 then running in a generally north westerly direction crossing Footpath 9 in a meandering line for approximately 430 metres to the termination point on Mount Pleasant Road at OS grid Reference SJ 65734 70638

That length of Public Footpath No 11 in the Parish of Davenham commencing at OS grid Reference SJ 65884 70482 then running in a south easterly direction for approximately 207 metres to OS grid reference SJ 66016 70323 to a new line commencing at OS grid reference SJ 66016 70323 then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to OS grid reference SJ 66011 70320 then north westerly then north easterly direction for approximately 62 metres to the proposed adopted highway at OS grid Reference SJ 65994 70366

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cheshire West and Chester Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
