The Order became operative as from the 1 December 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity of the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 of the Act have not been complied with in relation to it, he or she may, within 42 days of the 25 march 2021 make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12 of the said Schedule 15.
