The effect of the Order, as confirmed without modification, is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for Neston by upgrading to a Bridleway 52A, commencing at Bridleway 74 Neston also known as Flashes Lane at OS grid reference SJ 3074 7620 and running in a generally southerly direction for a distance of approximately 538 metres to the junction with Bridleway No 52B and Haddon Lane (UV1165) at OS grid reference SJ 3078 7567

AND adding a bridleway commencing at Flashes Lane (UV 1118) at OS grid reference SJ 3069 7621 and running in a generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 49.7 metres to Bridleway 52A Neston at OS grid reference SJ 3074 7620.

The Order became operative as from the 9 January 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity of the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 of the Act have not been complied with in relation to it, he or she may, within 42 days of the 16 January 2020 make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12 of the said Schedule 15.
