



# Community Support Centres for Older People

## Who we help and support

The four Community Support Centres together with Davenham Day Centre primarily support people over the age of 65. The people that we support are physically or mentally frail.

## What we do

People coming for either day care or a short stay do so following an assessment of their particular need for support. The number of days a week that a person comes to a centre or the number and length of short stays someone has, also depends on their particular support needs.

## Our commitments

We provide:

- Short stay services which are registered with the Care Quality Commission;
- Day care from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.30am. and 5.00pm;
- Short Stays which are available each day of the year;
- Services which are aimed at maximising a person's independence. In particular the short stay rehabilitation service undertaken in partnership with health colleagues at Lightfoot Lodge and Sutton Beeches;
- Services which help people to engage in a range of meaningful and stimulating activities either on a group or individual basis.
