What we do

We provide a service to people who have been assessed as needing day service support. Our services provide focused and flexible support with the goal of enhancing a person's well-being and quality of life. The overall aim is to promote independence, choice and control for those people receiving support.

Our day services take a person centred approach and provide opportunities for people to take up new challenges and experiences through a wide range of activities. As part of this approach we develop personal programmes of socially inclusive activities based within a person's local community.

We encourage people to make full use of their community – using the community centre, library, the learning zone, shops, leisure centres, cafes and pubs etc. With training and support people will have the opportunity to use their own bus passes to access their local community.

Our commitments are:

- Provide services that are person centred and focus on the shared goals and outcomes of the people that we support.
- Listen to people and also promote personal choice
- Provide partnership working with the people who use our services and their carers to design and develop new services
- Support family carers by providing information and practical support
- Encourage and support people to achieve their goals and aspirations.
