The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Stanthorne and Wimboldsley) Order 2015

Made - - - - 2015

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken community governance reviews of the parish of Stanthorne and of the parish of Wimboldsley and made recommendations dated 16th October 2014.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Stanthorne and Wimboldsley) Order 2015.
 - (2) Subject to paragraph (3) below, this order shall come into force on 1st April 2015.
 - (3) For the purposes of:
 - (a) this article, and

(b) article 6 (calculation of budget requirement),

this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Stanthorne and Wimboldsley Parish Map 2015" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act; and

"new parish" means the parish constituted by article 5.

Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Area affected by the Order

4. The area affected by this Order is shown on the map.

Amalgamation of existing parishes and constitution of new parish

- 5. (1) The existing parishes of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley shall be amalgamated to constitute a new parish comprising the area edged red on the map.
 - (2) The new parish shall be known as Stanthorne and Wimboldsley.
 - (3) In consequence of paragraph (1), the existing parishes of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley shall cease to exist.

Calculation of budget requirement

6. For the purposes of regulation 3 of the Local Government Finance (New Parishes) (England) Regulations 2008 there is specified in

relation to the parish of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley the sum of £0.00.

Warding

7. The parish of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley shall not be warded.

Revocations

8. Any previous orders concerning the community governance of the existing parishes of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley are revoked.

Order date

 1st April 2015 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council has undertaken community governance reviews of 161 existing parishes within the borough of Cheshire West and Chester and has made recommendations for the reorganisation of community governance to come into effect from 1st April 2015.

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance reviews for the parishes of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley. It provides for the amalgamation of the existing parishes to constitute the new parish of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley.

The new parish of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley will be created with effect from 1st April 2015.

The map defined in article 2 shows the new parish of Stanthorne and Wimboldsley. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council.
