The effect of the Order will be to divert the length of Public Footpath 25 in the parish of Christleton commencing at Christleton Footpath 078/FP3/1, OS grid reference SJ 4463 6629 (point B on Plan No. SD084A) then running in a generally north/north westerly direction for approximately 175 metres to the junction with Christleton Footpath 078/FP7/1 at OS grid reference SJ 4455 6645 (point A on Plan No SD084A) to a new line commencing at Christleton Footpath 078/FP3/1, OS grid reference SJ 44520 66262 (point D on Plan No. SD084A), then running in a generally north/north westerly direction for approximately 115 metres to the junction with Christleton Footpath 078/FP7/1, OS grid reference SJ 44460 66357 (point C on Plan No. SD084A).
