

Officer Decision Notice



The following decision has been taken under the Council's Constitution as amended.

Decision Maker: Senior Manager (Asset and Network)

Decision in matter of: Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 diverting Footpath 25 in the Parish of Christleton

Decision:

1. It is confirmed that a delegated officer decision report in respect of the above-mentioned matter has been prepared by the respective Public Right of Way Officer and notice of the same was sent to Councillors Stuart Parker and Mark Williams (Ward members for Christleton and Huntington).
2. A call-in period ran for fifteen working days from the date of notification of the delegated officer decision report as per the Councils Constitution (June 2025) Part 3/Page 151/para.83.
3. It is confirmed that the delegated officer decision report was not called in during the call-in period.
4. Accordingly, the Senior Manager (Asset and Network) being pursuant to delegated powers set out in the Council's Constitution does hereby confirm the recommendation contained in the application report (reproduced below) as a decision of the Council.

The Recommendation:-

- 1) That an Order be made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, diverting Footpath No.25 in the Parish of Christleton as shown on Plan No SD/084A by a black solid line on the grounds that it is expedient to do so in the interests of the landowners and occupiers of the land concerned.
- 2) That the Senior Manager (Asset and Network) be authorised to take any action considered necessary in respect of the confirmation of the Order duly authorised to be made.
